Rudolf A.Hillebrecht の画像では、SPR の近くが広く白雲に覆われている様子を示している。青の処理が強めになっているため、広く覆っているように見えるが、実際は Mare Sirenum の南側に眉状の帯になって見えるのが自然である。しかし、感度を上げると、広い範囲をベール状に覆っているということが分かる。右端の画像だと Arsia Silva Mons (W120,-3) に白雲が記録されてもよさそうだが、写っていない。この白雲は毎日出るといったことはないようだ。

The image of Rudolf A. Hillebrecht shows that the area near the SPR is widely covered with white clouds. It seems to cover a wide area due to the stronger blue treatment, but it is natural that it actually looks like an eyebrow band on the south side of Mare Sirenum. However, when the sensitivity is increased, it can be seen that it covers a wide area like a veil. In the image on the far right, it seems that white clouds may be recorded in Arsia Silva Mons (W120, -3), but they are not shown. This white cloud doesn't seem to come out every day.
