Clyde Foster の画像では、ここしばらくの間見えていた Hellas の中央にある Zea (W300, -590)がはっきりせず、どうもダスティーのようだ。かなり広い範囲が覆われており、淡い部分は Hellespontus (325W~345W,-30~-60)付近と Syrtis だけのようだ。Carsten Bauer は観測条件がよくなかったようだ。

In the image of Clyde Foster, Zea (W300, -590) in the center of Hellas, which has been visible for some time, is not clear. Apparently Dusty is around here. The dust covers a fairly wide area. The light part of the dust seems to be only around Hellespontus ( $325W \sim 345W$ , - $30 \sim -60$ ) and Syrtis. Carsten Bauer seems to have poor observation conditions.
