2022 年 7 月 8 日 (2022, Jul. 08)

今日は二人の観測者からの報告を受けた。ほぼ同じ経度を観測している。双方とも、北半球と南半球のリムを明るく記録している。南半球は、Hellas (275~315W,-30~60)の塵と朝霧がまじりあった姿で、北半球は Ishidis (270W,+23)盆地の雲だろう。Mare Cimmerium (W180~W250,-40~0)の北端は、今日もはっきり見ることができなかった。

I received reports from two observers today. We are observing almost the same longitude. Both have brightly recorded rims in the northern and southern hemispheres. The southern hemisphere is a mixture of Hellas (275  $\sim$  315W, -30  $\sim$  60) dust and morning mist, and the northern hemisphere is probably the Ishidis (270W, + 23) basin clouds. The northern end of Mare Cimmerium (W180  $\sim$  W250, -40  $\sim$  0) was not clearly visible today.
