Clyde Foster は前日と同じ位置の画像を報告してきた。Sinus Sabaeus (320W~350W,-10) が前日よりも全体が見やすくなっている。画像 処理による影響も排除できないが、Sinus Sabaeus 東端(左側)から Syrtis Major (293W,+0~20) の南部にかけてはダスティーな状態だ。

Clyde Foster has posted an image from the same location as the previous day. Sinus Sabaeus (320W $\sim$ 350W, -10) is now more visible than the previous day. While image processing may be an artifact, the area from the eastern end of Sinus Sabaeus (left) to the southern part of Syrtis Major (293W,  $+0\sim$ 20) is dusty.
